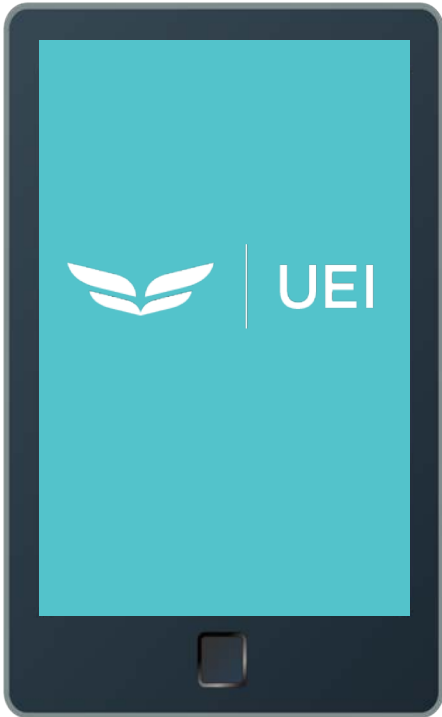

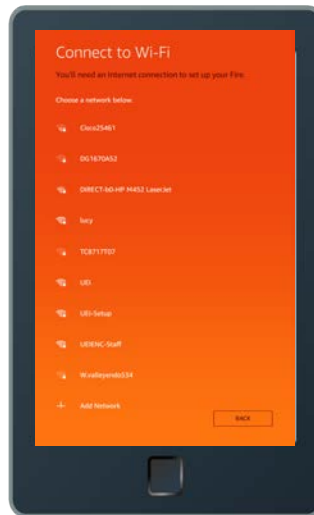
# Setting Up Your Kindle

## STEP 1 - 3



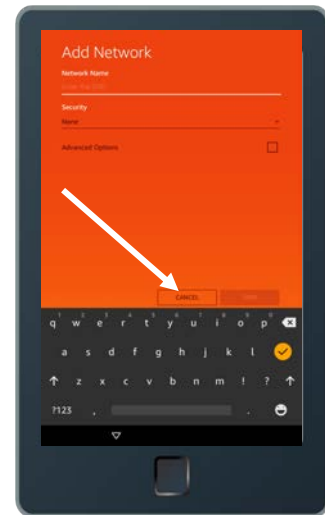
### STEP 1 | Language

Select the language and continue



### STEP 2 | Connect to WiFi

Select "Add Network" at the bottom of the list

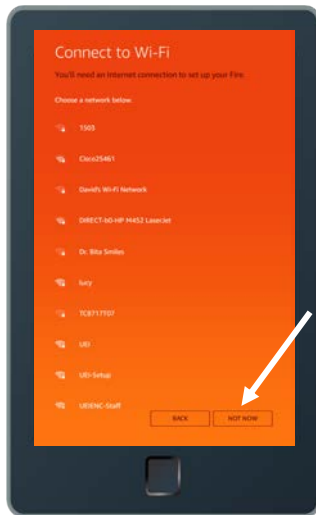


### STEP 3 | Network

**DO NOT** enter a network name. Just hit **CANCEL**.

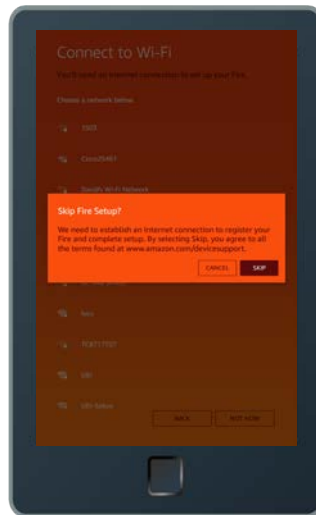

Select "SKIP"



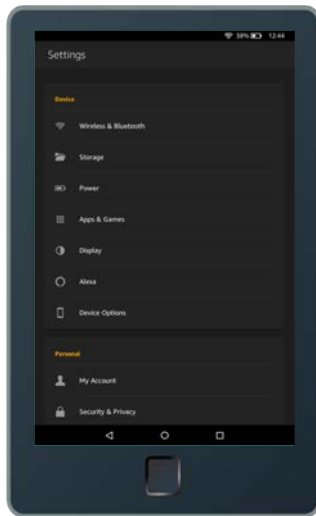
### STEP 6 | Settings

Select the Kindle "Settings" app



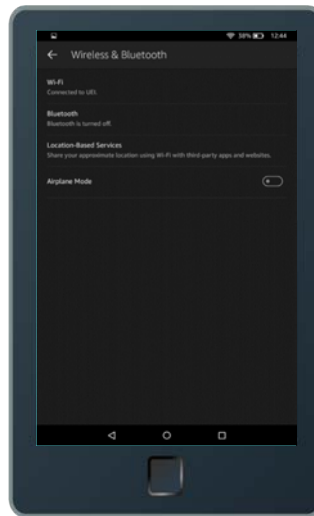
# Setting Up Your Kindle

## STEP 7 - 9



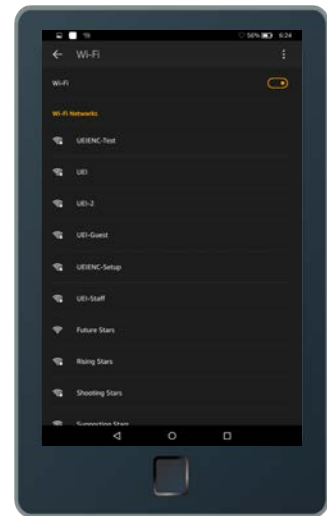
### STEP 7 | Connect to WiFi

### STEP 8 | Connect to WiFi

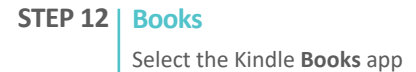
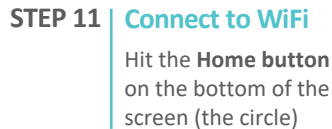
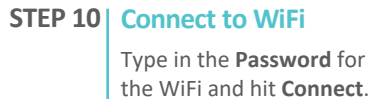
Select **“WiFi”**



### STEP 9 | Connect to WiFi

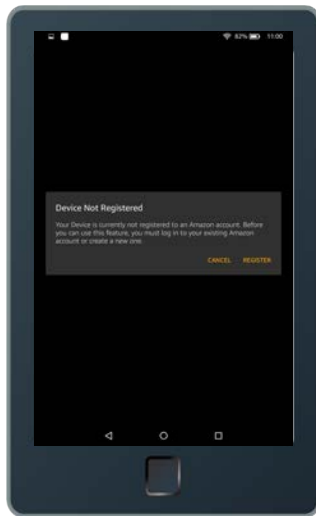
Select your **“Home WiFi Network”**

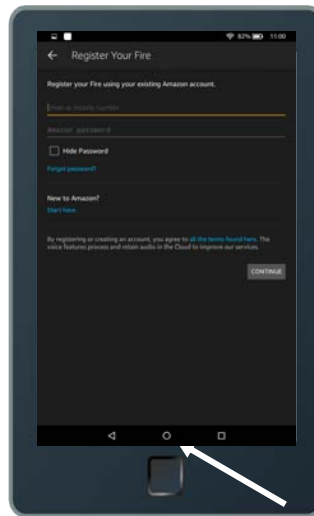

Enter the **Kindle Username** and **Password** assigned to you by the school, then select **Continue**.  
*This information will be on the sheet of paper that was given to you with your Kindle.*

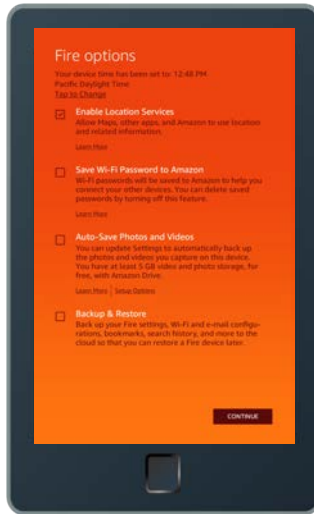
Go to [www.amazon.com](http://www.amazon.com)

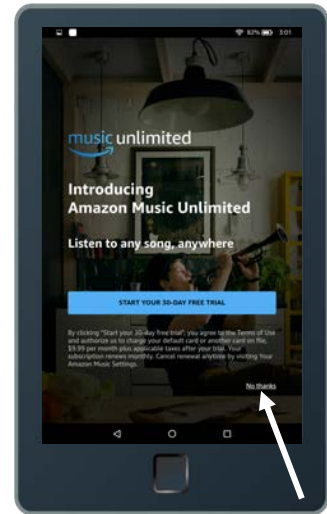
### STEP 15 | Fire Options
