Dear Mr. Blakely:

The Accrediting Commission of Career Schools and Colleges (“ACCSC” or “the Commission”) received the response to its February 19, 2025 letter directing United Education Institute to submit additional information in conjunction with the following:

 - Electrician Diploma (Diploma)

This is to inform you that the school has satisfied the requirements of the stipulation through documentation provided in response to the Commission’s letter and demonstrated compliance with the applicable accrediting requirements. Accordingly, the Commission’s February 19, 2025 decision is final.¹

Included with this letter is an ACCSC Approved Program Enclosure as documentation of the school’s approved programs. Although ACCSC accreditation is institutional in nature, all programs offered by the school must be approved by the Commission. United Education Institute will find the Commission’s requirements for the addition of new programs and modifications to existing programs in the *Standards of Accreditation*. Also included with this letter is an ACCSC Institutional Enhancement Enclosure with this letter, which lists suggested areas of improvement deserving the school’s attention and action.

In accordance with this action, the Commission is enclosing a copy of the school’s Certificate of Accreditation. Through the renewal of accreditation, United Education Institute has continued its partnership with other educators who are committed to providing programs of quality and to conducting their affairs with integrity. The Commission is confident that the school will take this responsibility seriously with consideration for the many other ACCSC-accredited institutions that have embraced accreditation as a means to enhance student learning and achieve educational goals.

The Commission expects that the school will adhere to the *Standards of Accreditation* on an on-going basis and as revisions are approved and disseminated. 
